In my time at school I have achieved much and learnt a great deal.

Achievements and experiences in education:

As well as receiving awards of distinction and credit in several areas of my academic studies I have been commended by outside organisations for my achievements in the subject of Mathematics. Firstly in 1996 I successfully completed the Greater Manchester Mathematics Challenge and in 1997. I participated in the UK Junior Mathematical Challenge for which I received a Bronze Certificate for the United Kingdom Mathematical Trust.

Last Year I was asked to offer my comments and be a judge on a panel awarding children's authors the Carnegie Medal. This was thoroughly compelling and enjoyable experience for me as English is one of my favourite subjects.

Contribution to school life:

For my whole time at school I have been elected by my peers to be my form representative on the School Council. I believe I fulfilled this role to the best of my ability and have sought to represent the views of as many people in my form as possible.

In Year 7 I took the role of junior reporter for the school newspaper, The Phoenix. I have continued to pursue the interest ever since and have helped in the production of over 15 issues. The experience I have gained and the talent I have developed over this time has led to position of Editor which I am currently performing.

Again my interest in the media has led to the involvement in the school television and radio station. Here I have been involved in a wide range of tasks including presenting broadcasts and helping to organise events such as the annual fashion show. The second major project I participated in was the production of the theatre performance "The King With Cold Feet" at the Lawrence Batley Theatre.

In July 1999 I was chosen to be school prefect by members of staff. I took on the responsibility of mentor to a group of thirty pupils in the lower school as well as helping out at events in the school calendar such

as Parents' Evening.

Also as part of my duties I was invited to speak at the annual Awards Evening, on the behalf of my peers, I congratulated the former pupils on their success in the recent GCSE examinations. Following this speech I was then asked to be the Senior Speaker at the Christmas Concert staged for staff and pupils.

I have been actively involved in a variety of sporting activities and have been keen to develop my skills in all areas.
